





Introduction To Indian Pharma Industry

- The country's pharmaceutical sector contributes 6.6% to the total merchandise exports.
- Indian drugs are exported to more than 200 countries in the world, with US being the key market. Generic drugs account for 20% of the global export in terms of volume, making the country the largest provider of generic medicines globally
- 'Pharma Vision 2020' by the Government's Department of Pharmaceuticals aims to make India a major hub for end-to-end drug discovery.
- The Indian drugs and pharmaceuticals sector has received cumulative FDI inflows worth US\$ 17.75 billion between April 2000 and December 2020.










