


# **RENDEZVOUS 2022-23 Industry Expert Lecture**

### **Event Details:**

The event was organized in three sessions with three different speakers from various experience background. In the morning, the event was inaugurated with a traditional Lamp Lightning Ceremony by the auspicious hands of Principal and other deleates.

The First Industrial Expert Lecture was conducted by **Ms. Bhakti R. Mayekar**, *Quality Control Officer & Member of Audit Tral Committee, Corporate FDC Pharma Ltd., Goa* on the Topic **"Industrial Guideline & Ethics"**. Ms. Bhakti R. Mayekar, who is also an alumnus of Yashwatrao Bhonsale College of Pharmacy, Sawantwadi, explained the importance of discipline, punctuality, honesty and ethical practices in the pharma industries. She shared her day-to-day experiences with the students in very energetic interactive way.



In the second Lecture, **Mr. Sandeep J. Nanoskar**, *Senior Quality Executive, Centaur Pharmaceuticals Pvt. Ltd., Mapusa, Goa*, shared his knowledge on "Good Manufacturing Practices." He mentioned that, in pharma industries Quality has the utmost priority and that can be achieved by performing all the activities carefully in step-by-step manner. To ensure this, every industry provides some important standard guidelines, which are known as GMP.

In the post lunch session, **Mr. Sanjeev Gubbi**, *Project Manager, R & D, Teva Pharmaceuticals, Goa* had an interaction with students on, "Basics of Tablet Manufacturing-Industrial Perspective." In this very interactive session, he let the student recall & repeat the fundamentals of Tablet Manufacturing Processes, problems related to tablet manufacturing and then very fluently explained how the industry look at these basics, how they face & solve the problems etc.

These Industrial Expert Lectures were mainly targeted for the Third and Final Year B. Pharm. and Second Year D. Pharm. students. Total 327 delegates get benefited from these expert lectures.
